Every overdose death is a drug policy failure.

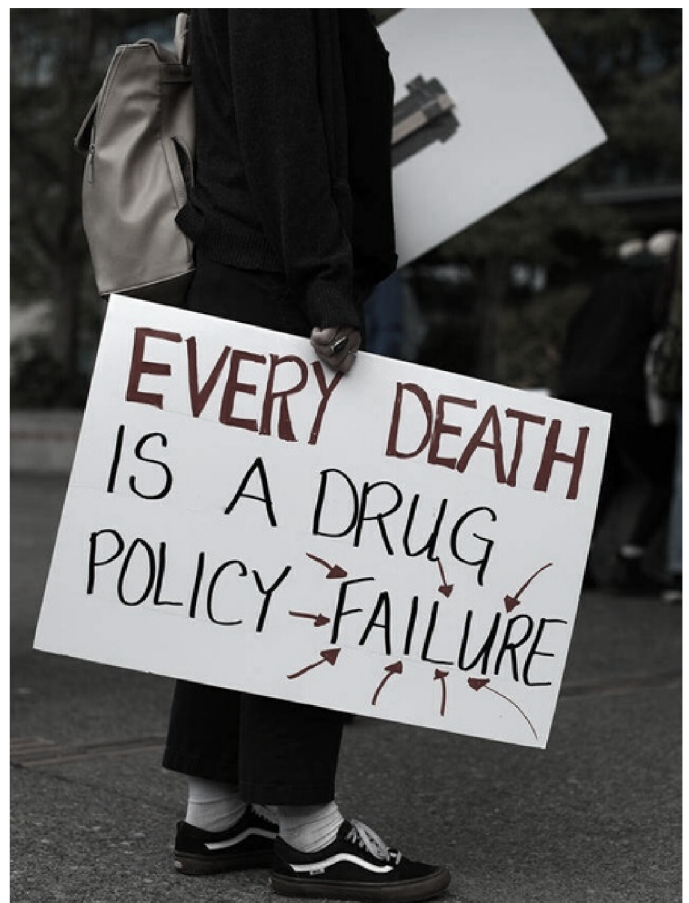
The lack of political willpower to support common sense, scientific solutions is putting human lives at risk.

Event Background It has been more than two decades since the overdose crisis began, damaging communities and taking the lives of our loved ones. Even with broad steps taken, more people than ever are dying. Why? **The root causes have not been addressed, and proven solutions await real investment and legislative support.**

Event Purpose **#EndOverdoseNowIL** is our moment to remember the lives lost to drug deaths, uplift the voices of those impacted, create awareness about the overdose crisis, and educate the public and lawmakers about lifesaving solutions.

WHAT DO WE WANT?

We want Illinois leaders to prioritize people over politics. Every drug death is a policy failure. **#EndOverdoseNowIL**



1. Harm Reduction is Health

Naloxone and safe supplies distribution, drug checking, and nonjudgmental outreach are essential services. Authorizing the state to allow Overdose Prevention Sites (OPS) pilot by passing HB2/SB78 will save lives on day one.



3. Expand Care Access

People who use drugs struggle to access methadone, counseling, housing, job training, and basic needs like food and showers despite budget investments.



2. No More Drug War

The war on drugs is a war on people, especially Black and Brown communities. Many Illinois laws still prioritize punishment over support for people who use drugs. It's wrong, expensive, and has failed us.



4. Fund Peer-Led Services

Community-based organizations keep people who use drugs alive, connected, and engaged. While heavily relied upon across the state, peer-led groups are grossly underfunded. Investing in us makes Illinois more equitable, safe, and compassion-driven.
